Let Your Voice Be Heard - Liz Wilder

To balance the state budget, our Senate and Assembly are considering a measure to limit the tax deductibility of gifts from high net worth individuals to nonprofits. Donors earning \$10 million or more would be limited to 25% deduction for their gifts.

Please oppose this legislation by sending a letter and memorandum of opposition to your state assemblyman and senator. This measure has already passed the Assembly and will soon be considered in the Senate. Please act swiftly. Samples of both of these letters are available on the AFPGV [website](#).
